Hyacinth oreintalis 'Pink Pearl' - Highly fragrant, award winning Hyacinth 'Pink Pearl' has dense spikes of fuschia-purple flowers edged in pale pink above bright green leaves. Blooming in mid spring it will stay in bloom for 3-4 weeks. These deer and rabbit resistant blooms are an excellent choice for planting near walkways and patios to enjoy their perfumed scent. You'll need about 4 per square foot. Grows 6-10 inches tall in zones 4-8.

The Drumstick Allium. This terrific naturalizing heirloom has dense, egg-shaped composite flowers that open green and mature to rich crimson-purple. Perched atop two foot

tall wiry, yet strong stems, 1"- to 1 1/2"-wide round composite flowers dance in the breeze as the individual florets open from the top down with shimmery silver-white stamen. Each composite Best planted en masse, perfect for thick drifts in mixed perennial beds, meadows and natural settings. Don't let anyone weed the thin wiry stems as they emerge in late spring! It too is rabbit-, rodent- and deer-resistant and much loved by bees, butterflies and helpful pollinators. Bulb size: 6 cm/up. July. 24". HZ: 4-9.





Narcissus Ice Follies - A spectacular award-winner has a large 4" flower with icy-white petals surrounding a flat, frilled, sunny chartreuse-yellow crown that magically turns white. It is a terrific naturalizer as well as a good forcer. Narcissus Class: Large Cupped (Royal Horticultural Society Division 2). Bulb size: 14/16 cm. April. 18" to 20". HZ: 3-7.

Mixture - Each variety in the Ravishing All-Pink Mixture has ivory to white petals and apricot, pink or rose cups or cup edges. Best planted in filtered sunlight for true color development, these beauties develop their appealing pink tones as the flowers mature. It is a stunning mixture for display beds, naturalized drifts and woodland plantings. Narcissus Classes: Large Cupped, Double and Jonquilla (Royal Horticultural Society Divisions 2, 4, and 7). Bulb size: DNII. April/May. 16" to 20". HZ: 3-7.
